News from the PA

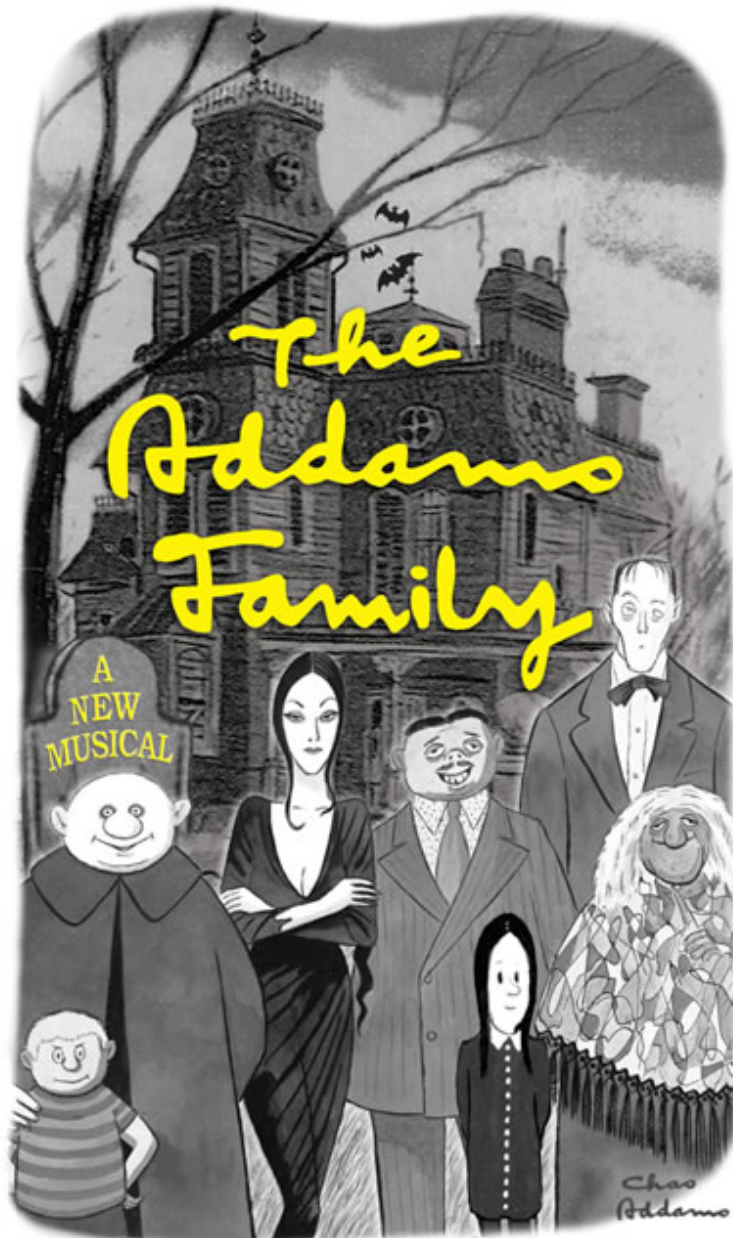

Dear Seniors and Parents of the Graduating Class of 2016,
I hope you are enjoying your last months at SOF. As we get closer to the end of your High School career please take a look below and make note of important information and dues:

Senior Dues are \$200.00. Payment is due as soon as possible. The dues cover graduation expenses such as the graduation space, cap & gowns, the Senior BBQ, the traditional SOF graduation bulldog as well as the school yearbook. All checks submitted for senior dues can be made to School of the Future. If you are taking part in the graduation you have to pay the whole \$200

Cost for Prom- \$80.00 per person: The cost for prom includes catering for prom, rental for the prom location, decorations, a DJ and chaperones. Please note that tickets for couples are a total of \$160. Upon payment for ticket, every student will receive an email with prom information. Prom will be on May 26th from 7pm-11pm and it will take place at the Midtown Loft and Terrace located at 267 5th Ave (corner of 29th and 5th).
