12th grade AP Literature	3-ring binder, marble composition notebook
11th grade AP Language and 12th grade English	Composition notebook, folder with pockets, colored pencils/pen, or crayons
11th grade English	folder for handouts, marble composition notebook
12th grade Statistics/Calculus	Composition Notebook (Graph ruled is preferable, college ruled is acceptable), 2-pocket folder, TI-83 Graphing Calculator (suggested, but not required).
11th grade Geometry	Notebook or binder with lined paper, 1 graph paper notebook, folder for handouts, pencils, scientific or graphing calculator (Highly Recommended)
Physics/Physics II	3-Ring binder with dividers & one folder, scientific calculator (Highly Recommended), Pencils
Computer Science	a graph paper notebook OR graph paper in a binder, 2 highlighters (any colors but different), pen or pencil
11th & 12th grade History	Spiral bound notebook or college ruled loose leaf (NO composition notebooks), binder or folders for handouts, pens (black or blue) and pencils Optional: flash drive *You will be receiving numerous handouts throughout the year including essential course readings.
