10th grade supplies

General:

Tissues, hand sanitizer, Lysol wipes, dry erase markers (black and color), paper towels

Math:

3 ring binder (1 inch) just for math with 5-pack dividers, lots of loose leaf paper, graph paper, pencils, black or blue pens, pencil case, Casio scientific calculator (recommended), highlighter and colored pencils, two packs of index cards, ruler

Spanish:

One single subject notebook, index cards

Mandarin:

3 calligraphy pens, 1 single subject notebook, pencils, eraser, ruler, glue stick, loose leaf paper, colored paper, one two-pocket folder, one pack of post-its, one pack of index cards_

Chemistry:

3-ring binder or notebook just for chemistry

English

1. Make sure you have a library card.
2. Prepare an organized, quiet, place where you will be able to study. It should have a clear calendar where you can post assignments that are due and track your progress toward meeting deadlines.
3. Arrange to have access to a computer where you can type your assignments.
4. Post-Its (You can get the cheapest, any size). You should have about 300 total.
5. Most work will be done on Google Classroom.

A 3 ring binder (1/2 inch) is good for most people.

However, many people with organizational challenges prefer a spiral or marble bound notebook instead.

Any of these three options are fine.
