- *What do I feel are my biggest accomplishments?*
- *How do I feel about math group work? Do I tend to let others do most of the work or stay on the sidelines? How did I engage in math group work during this past year?*
- *How do I study/time manage my work?*
- *What is a short term and a long term goal I have for myself this year in math class and/or in school?*
- *What makes an effective math teacher in your opinion?*
- *What are some things you liked about Mr. Brostrom and/or Ms. Kramer's class that you hope we keep up?*
- *What were your likes and dislikes of using Desmos?*
- *How did you feel about the 1-4 grading scale and using Competency based grading and JumpRope?*
- ***What was one of the best things about school this past year? What was something you wish you could redo about this school year (doesn't necessarily have to be academic)?***
